About Dana-Farber Cancer Institute

Since its founding in 1947 by the late Sidney Farber, MD, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute has been committed to offering cancer patients the best treatment available today, while developing tomorrow's cures through research. At the same time, Dana-Farber trains new generations of physicians and scientists to advance the understanding and prevention of cancer and related diseases.

Dana-Farber is:

- a principal teaching affiliate of Harvard Medical School.
- a founding member of the Dana-Farber/Harvard Cancer Center (DF/HCC), which is one of 40 NCI-designated Comprehensive Cancer Centers in the United States.
- a founding member of the Center for AIDS Research at Harvard University and one of 20 federally designated Centers for AIDS Research.
- a pioneer in the development of cancer treatments used around the world.
- accredited with Magnet status from the American Nurses Credentialing Center – an honor held by just 6 percent of hospitals in the United States.
- a collaborator with Brigham and Women's Hospital in adult cancer care (Dana-Farber/Brigham and Women's Cancer Center), and with Children's Hospital Boston in pediatric cancer care (Dana-Farber/Children's Hospital Cancer Center).
- one of the top recipients, among independent hospitals, of grant funding from the National Cancer Institute and National Institutes of Health.
- a provider of innovative therapies and hope to patients from 50 states and dozens of countries around the world.

About the Jimmy Fund

The Jimmy Fund raises vital funds to support adult and pediatric cancer care and research at Dana-Farber. Since 1948, the generosity of millions of people has helped the Jimmy Fund save countless lives and reduce the burden of cancer.

The Jimmy Fund has:

- raised more than \$750 million since 1948, including \$61 million in 2010. Eighty-nine cents of every dollar raised supports Dana-Farber's lifesaving mission.
- been integral to the success of treatments for once-incurable childhood cancers. Today, cure rates for childhood cancers have surpassed 75 percent, and are at more than 90 percent for some forms of the disease.
- been an official charity of the Boston Red Sox since 1953, making it the nation's longest philanthropic partnership with a professional sports team.
- been the official charity of the Massachusetts Chiefs of Police Association since 1953, the Pan-Massachusetts Challenge bike-a-thon since 1980, and the Variety Children's Charity of New England since 1948.
- drawn nearly 4,500 volunteers annually to help organize and support its 585 fundraising events and programs.
- become widely regarded as one of New England's and the nation's favorite charities.

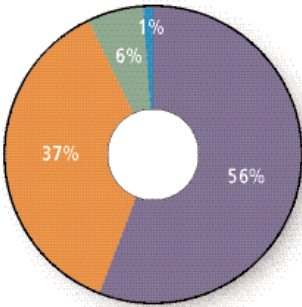

Income and Expenses in thousands

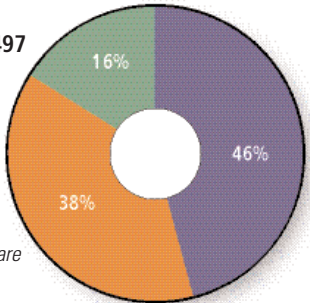


Revenues – \$883,218

From Bench to Bedside

Research in laboratories and clinics is at the core of Dana-Farber's mission. Through basic and clinical investigations, we work to unravel the complex riddles of cancer and improve patient care.

Treatment Centers

Adult – Adult patients at Dana-Farber are treated in specialized centers, each devoted to fighting a different type of disease. The Institute shares care responsibilities with several other Harvard-affiliated hospitals, giving patients access to a broad range of specialists. Adult care is delivered through Dana-Farber/Brigham and Women's Cancer Center (DF/BWCC), which largely provides outpatient care at Dana-Farber and inpatient services at Brigham and Women's Hospital.

Clinicians from various disciplines work in each treatment center – a team approach that allows many patients to see all of their specialists in one visit. The adult treatment centers include: breast, cutaneous, endocrine, gastrointestinal, genitourinary, gynecologic, head and neck, hematologic oncology, hematology, melanoma, neurologic, sarcoma, and thoracic.

Pediatric – For more than 60 years, Dana-Farber and Children's Hospital Boston have worked together to provide the best care available to children with cancer, blood disorders, and related conditions. Outpatients are seen at Dana-Farber's Jimmy Fund Clinic, while patients requiring hospitalization are treated at Children's.

Treatment programs include: bone and soft tissue tumors, brain tumors, kidney/liver tumors, leukemia, lymphoma, solid tumors, and stem cell transplantation. Dana-Farber also offers an array of services for patients and families, such as counseling, integrative therapies, nutrition, survivorship, pain and palliative care, and spiritual care.

Dana-Farber in your community – We offer services and care in Boston and at our satellite centers in neighboring communities, including: DF/BWCC at Faulkner Hospital, in Boston's Jamaica Plain neighborhood; DF/BWCC at Milford Regional Medical Center, in

Milford, Mass.; DF/BWCC in clinical affiliation with South Shore Hospital, in South Weymouth, Mass.; and Dana-Farber/New Hampshire Oncology-Hematology, in Londonderry, NH. These satellite centers allow patients to access Dana-Farber's expertise and resources close to home.
