

Dana-Farber's Digital Art Display

Application

We receive a significant number of requests to publicly display artwork created by patients and families at Dana-Farber. While we are unable to accept patient artwork for *permanent* exhibition, you can submit artwork to be considered for *Dana-Farber's Digital Art Display*, which hosts a digital image of your artwork on a large video screen in the Eleanor and Maxwell Blum Patient and Family Resource Center (first floor of the Yawkey Center).

The Digital Art Display is intended to support the Dana-Farber community and provide a unique opportunity for its patients and visitors. All selected art pieces are displayed on a large video screen along with a limited rotation of other selected Dana-Farber community artworks. The display is open weekdays from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Pieces are rotated quarterly to ensure that all interested community members can participate.

Submissions from all visual mediums and level of ability are welcome. To have your original artwork considered for this opportunity, please complete this form and submit it along with a *high-resolution digital photograph* of the art. Artwork should adhere to the following guidelines:

- Culturally sensitive and inclusive
- Positive in its message
- Enjoyable to view

If your artwork is accepted, you agree that acceptance of the gift by the Institute is subject to the following conditions:

1. The image of the artwork shall be accepted free of any conditions or limitations set by the donor.
