### **Biography**

Stephanie has worked at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute since 1990. In a career that spans more than 30 years, she has worked as an inpatient nurse, an outpatient infusion nurse, and in her current role of clinical research nurse. Prior to joining the gynecologic oncology team as a research nurse in 2012 she held the same role in genitourinary oncology for 12 years. She enjoys caring for patients with ovarian, uterine, cervical, and other gynecologic malignancies.

Stephanie has been a peer mentor and a co-author on multiple publications for both genitourinary and gynecologic oncology. She recently participated in the development of an app for patients to use as a tool to manage their side effects while taking a targeted anti-cancer medication. She collaborated with the industry sponsor, the application developer, and nurses from three major cancer centers. Their work was published and later presented at a national nursing conference.

Her daughters have followed a similar path, with one working at Dana-Farber in the Division of Philanthropy, one working as an oncology nurse at Brigham and Women's Hospital, and another studying nursing at Northeastern University.
