**Biography**

Elizabeth has been an oncology nurse navigator in the Gynecologic Oncology Program since November 2015. She serves on the Nursing Council at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and is a member of the Oncology Nurse Navigator Committee, Nursing Informatics Committee, and Patient Handoff Workgroup.

Before becoming an oncology nurse navigator, she worked at Dana-Farber as a research nurse in the Early Drug Development Center on phase 1 clinical trials. Prior to joining Dana-Farber, she was a staff nurse in gastrointestinal oncology at Karmanos Cancer Institute in Detroit, Michigan.

Elizabeth received her master's degree in nursing at Rush University. During graduate school she served as an Albert Schweitzer Fellow where she provided over 200 hours of direct service, addressing health-related needs to underserved communities in Chicago. She designed and created a service project partnering with Gilda's Club Chicago and two Chicago hospitals to provide psychosocial cancer support programming.
