Dr. Maingi is a board-certified hematologist, medical oncologist, and palliative care physician who is involved in medical education and health disparities research. She has over a dozen accepted abstracts and publications on the experiences of LGBTQ+ patients facing cancer and terminal illnesses. Dr. Maingi was the founding chair of the American Academy of Hospice and Palliative Medicine's LGBT Special Interest Group. She serves on the Board of the Gay and Lesbian Medical Association (GLMA): Health Professionals Advancing LGBTQ Equality, and heads their racial justice task force.

Dr. Maingi currently serves on ASCO's Diversity and Inclusion Committee, Practice Health Task Force, and as co-chair of the Sexual and Gender Minority (SGM) Task Force for the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO). She also served as Track Leader for the Survivorship and Symptom Management scientific program at ASCO's 2021 conference.
